### Call for Papers

The upcoming conference EnviroInfo Vienna 2002 will cover the complete field of environmental communication, including computer networks, the Internet, the media, mediation and face-to-face interaction. It focuses on informatics applications for the environment including the identification of pressures, the monitoring of environmental status and threats, the localisation of impacts from human activities and taking suitable responses for sanitation and prevention. Papers are invited discussing research, theory and practice of communication processes. An international program committee assembled from leading thinkers and practitioners from administration, business and academia worldwide will review the contributions.
