September 25-27, 2002 Technical University Vienna, Austria

Rationale

EnviroInfo will comprise the field of informatics applications for the environment, including the identification of pressures, the monitoring of environmental status and threats, the localisation of impacts from human activities and taking suitable responses for sanitation and prevention.
